This is a special month because of "Valentine's Day". Although we should do this every day of our lives, Valentine's Day is the day to let your loved one know how much you care for them.

Welcome

Now that all of our winter owners and renters are here, I ask that you all take time to review the rules that we have here at Sea Towers. Please remember that as owners, you are responsible for the actions of your guests and renters. Please inform your guests of the rules that we have here at Sea Towers. The best way of enforcement of Rules and Regulations is self-enforcement. In a gated community the size of Sea Towers, rules are a necessity in order for the type of living that you all enjoy.

Contractors

Please be sure to remind any Service people that you may have in your units that they need to park in the spots designated for Service for your building. These spots are clearly labeled. If they are driving a truck, they need to be off property by 5:30 PM. Any trucks that are still on property after 5:30 PM are subject to having their vehicle towed without notice.

Alterations

Another reminder to those of you who are not aware, if you are planning any alteration in your unit, an Alteration Form must be completed, notarized and approved before any alterations can begin. Alteration Forms are readily available in the Administration Office. We also have notaries on staff to aid you in the notarization of the Alteration Form. **Don't forget that it is your responsibility** as owners to make sure your contractor or service person obtains any applicable permits that are required for the work that you are having done. I suggest that you ask your contractor where the permit is before any work is begun. It must be adequately displayed to be seen from the outside of your home. (The alteration Form mentioned above is not a permit).

Gate House

It is always a good idea to call the Guards with any information regarding Guests or Contracors/Services that you may have coming to see you. When calling the Guards, please remember to give the Officers your first and last name, your unit number, and your phone number as well as the first and last names of your guest or the name of the Service Company that you are expecting. Keep in mind that the Guards are trying to write all of this information down as you are giving it to them along with taking care of any vehicles that are entering the property.

Rentals

When you as unit owners rent your unit, remember that the use of the amenities goes with the unit. This means that if you rent your unit, your renter gets full rights to the amenities, and you give up your right to use them. This includes your gate decal and South Gate access cards.

Sales and Leases

Please remember, any pending lease or sale applications must be completed and turned into the Office not less than 20 business days prior to desired occupancy. This allows the Office staff plenty of time to do necessary paperwork for approval.

Traffic Signs

The One-Way signs throughout the complex are there not only to help control traffic flow, but also for safety. Bicycle riders must obey the traffic signs as well as automobiles.

Remember It takes all of us working together to keep Sea Towers as nice as it is. Thank you for your continued co-operation.




FROM THE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE

GATE ACCESS PROCEDURES

If you are new to Sea Towers welcome, if you are a returning to Sea Towers welcome back. The following are some tips to insure your guests or contractor get through the gate quickly.

- Please call the gate no more than twelve hours prior to your guest/contractor arrival. The gate is not set up for any further advance notice then twelve hours.
- Please do not walk up to the gatehouse, to request a guest or contractor entry, the gate at Sea Towers is not a pedestrian gate, it is not safe. In addition, the officers must direct their attention to the entry lanes and the phone, before they can speak to you as a walk up.
- 3. If you are an owner or renter, not in your decaled vehicle. Please have your I.D. ready to show the officer.
- Please let your guests or contractor know your building name, unit number, and your name. This will speed up their entry.
- Let the officer know if the person you are expecting is a contractor or guest. If they are a contractor, what are they doing i.e. maid/cleaning service, providing an estimate for work, A/C or water heater install, painting, carpeting, etc.
- It is not necessary to let the officer know what type of vehicle your guests or contractor is in.
- Security officers are <u>not</u> allowed to hold, accept or sign for keys, mail, luggage, deliveries, etc.
